13 Jesus Begins His Work

"And when Jesus had finished instructing his twelve disciples, he went on from there to teach and preach in their cities."

Matthew 11:1

When Jesus had grown up and was thirty years old, He left Nazareth. He knew it was time to begin His work. He walked from town to town and taught. He was a **teacher**, someone who shares with others the things that he knows so that they can know them too. He wanted everyone to learn about God.

He told people things about God that they never knew before, and He taught them how to love God better. Sometimes Jesus would teach large crowds, lots and lots of people. Sometimes He spoke to people one at a time.

Jesus liked to spend time with children. He liked to tell them how much their heavenly Father loved them. He put His arms around the children and then gave them His blessing.

Jesus picked twelve men to help him in a special way. These men were called the Twelve Apostles. They left their homes and went everywhere with Jesus. The Twelve Apostles listened to His teachings and then they told other people about Jesus. Later, additional men were chosen to be Apostles. The Apostles were the first bishops of the Church. They helped other people to follow Jesus. These other followers of Jesus we call disciples.

We, too, can be disciples of Jesus. We must listen to what our parents and teachers say about Him. We should tell others about Him. We should remember that Jesus is always near us.



"Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them; for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven."


Matthew 19:14
